


Sam Son is an easy armchair with a hint of a cartoon character. Supported on four stilt legs, the armchair features a softly suspended seat shell between a giant, horseshoe-shaped element, the chair's characteristic armrest and backrest. Made from two different rotational mouldings, the armchair combines a rigid plastic

for its base and a more elastic polymer for the upper part.

The exaggerated size of the armrest and backrest provides comfort and support and creates a protective space for sitting. Sam Son comes in four different colours and is suitable for both indoors and outdoors.



Konstantin Grcic was born in 1965 and studied Design at the Royal College of Art in London. Since setting up his own practice, Konstantin Grcic Industrial Design (KGID), in Munich in 1991, he has developed furniture, products and lighting for some of the leading companies in the design field. Konstantin Grcic defines function in human terms, combining strict forms with considerable mental acuity and humour. Each of his products expresses a careful research into the history of design and architecture, and his passion for technology and materials. Known for his pared-down pieces, Grcic is often called a minimalist, but the designer himself prefers to speak of simplicity.
